1. ***Sing Aloud: Amazing Grace: vs 1--Amazing Grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me. I once was lost but now I'm found, was blind but now I see.***
2. ***Real aloud Psalm 18:1-2--I love you Lord; you are my strength. The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my savior; my God is my rock, in whom I find protection. He is my shield, the power that saves me, and my place of safety.***
3. ***Read aloud Isaiah 41:10--Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand.***
4. ***Sing vs 3 Amazing Grace--Through many dangers, toils and snares, I have already come. 'Tis grace that brought me safe thus far, and grace will lead me home.***
5. ***Pray aloud the Lord's Prayer--Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who have trespassed against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.***
6. ***Pray aloud Glory Be to the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, as it was, in the beginning, is now and ever shall be. Amen.***
7. ***Sing Aloud: Amazing Grace: vs 1--Amazing Grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me. I once was lost but now I'm found, was blind but now I see***
8. ***Say Aloud: Praise God, Alleluia (repeat 3 times)***
9. ***Say Aloud: AMEN!***
